Level 4: Sapling



- Demonstrate reduction of energy use, water use, or landfill waste over the last 1 – 3 years within a minimum of one area: energy, waste, or water and record efforts/achievements in relevant Snapshot Form(s) *when pursuing energy use reduction, an alternate option is achieving an Energy Star score of 75
- Put a plan in place to start measuring all waste, energy, and water for the entire school
- Achieve at least Tier 2 for 2 Educational Programming START metrics and record efforts/achievements in relevant Snapshot Form(s)
- Achieve at least Tier 2 for 5 Organizational Culture START metrics and record efforts/achievements in relevant Snapshot Form(s)
- All Seedling level criteria met

- Achieve at least Tier 2 for 5 Educational Programming START metrics and record efforts/achievements in relevant Snapshot Form(s)
- Achieve at least Tier 2 for 10 Organizational Culture START metrics and record efforts/achievements in relevant Snapshot Form(s)
- Achieve at least Tier 1 for a minimum of 10 Physical Place START Metrics and record efforts/achievements in relevant Snapshot form(s)
- Provide one contact to serve as a mentor to other schools
